- Project Details:** Project Title, Task/Activity, Risk Assess. No. (A35), Project No., Date Prepared.
- HAZARDS:** A table with columns for Ref., Key hazards associated with the above task/activity, Location, Severity, and Risk. It includes a 'Risk Assessment Scores' legend: 10-15 Very High Risk, 6-9 High Risk, 1-4 Low Risk.
- PERSONS AFFECTED:** A table with columns for Operatives, Members of Public, Site Visitors, Other Workers, Managers, Young Persons, and Others.
- PPE REQUIREMENTS:** A table with columns for Harness & Lanyard, Hi-Viz Clothing, Hearing Protection, Respiratory Protection, Eye Protection, and Head Protection.
- ADDITIONAL CONTROLS:** A table with columns for Information/Instruction/Training, Physical Controls, HSE & Other Guidance, and Comments.

The main part of the form is for the identification of the hazards and the assessment of the risks, extra lines can be added as required

The final part of the form provides space for specifying the control measures, training requirements and general comments et

The central part of the form is used to identify the persons likely to be affected by the hazards and the PPE that should be used
